Aim of the Info day:

The primary objective of this event is to promote **Marie Skłodowska-Curie Postdoctoral Fellowships (MSCA-PF)** in Egypt, with the aim of increasing the number of Egyptian institutions hosting international researchers through the MSCA PF scheme.

In particular, the event seeks to raise awareness among Egyptian universities, research centres, public administrations, and non-academic institutions about their eligibility to participate as **host institutions** under the **MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships 2026 and 2027 calls**. Egyptian institutions may act as **European Fellowship (EF) beneficiaries**, and, in the case of **Global Fellowships (GF)**, as hosting institutions for Fellows spending **12–24 months in Third Countries**.

Given Egypt’s association to **Horizon Europe**, which grants Egyptian entities access to the programme on equal terms with EU Member States, this event aims to strengthen institutional capacity and understanding of MSCA opportunities, which are still relatively new for many organisations in Egypt.

Through targeted **awareness-raising activities**, including an online session titled “*How to Attract Researchers to Your Institution*”, the event will provide practical guidance on attracting and hosting MSCA-funded researchers. At least **10 different Egyptian institutions** are expected to participate or be represented during the MSCA PF information session.

Ultimately, the event aims to contribute to a **measurable increase in MSCA PF applications** involving Egyptian host institutions, thereby strengthening Egypt’s role as an attractive destination for excellent international researchers and fostering long-term research and innovation collaboration.

In addition, while the event is primarily focused on the **MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF)**, it will also highlight how Egyptian institutions can attract and host researchers through other MSCA schemes, notably **Doctoral Networks (DN)** and **COFUND**. A concise overview of these calls are included in the agenda to illustrate complementary pathways for institutional engagement and researcher recruitment under the MSCA framework.

The event is organised in close cooperation with the **Academy of Scientific Research and Technology (ASRT)**, which actively promotes participation in Horizon Europe, MSCA, PRIMA, and other international R&I programmes, as well as with the **European Commission**, the **MSCA-GLOPOL project** and the **Marie Curie Alumni Association Africa and Middle East Chapter**.
