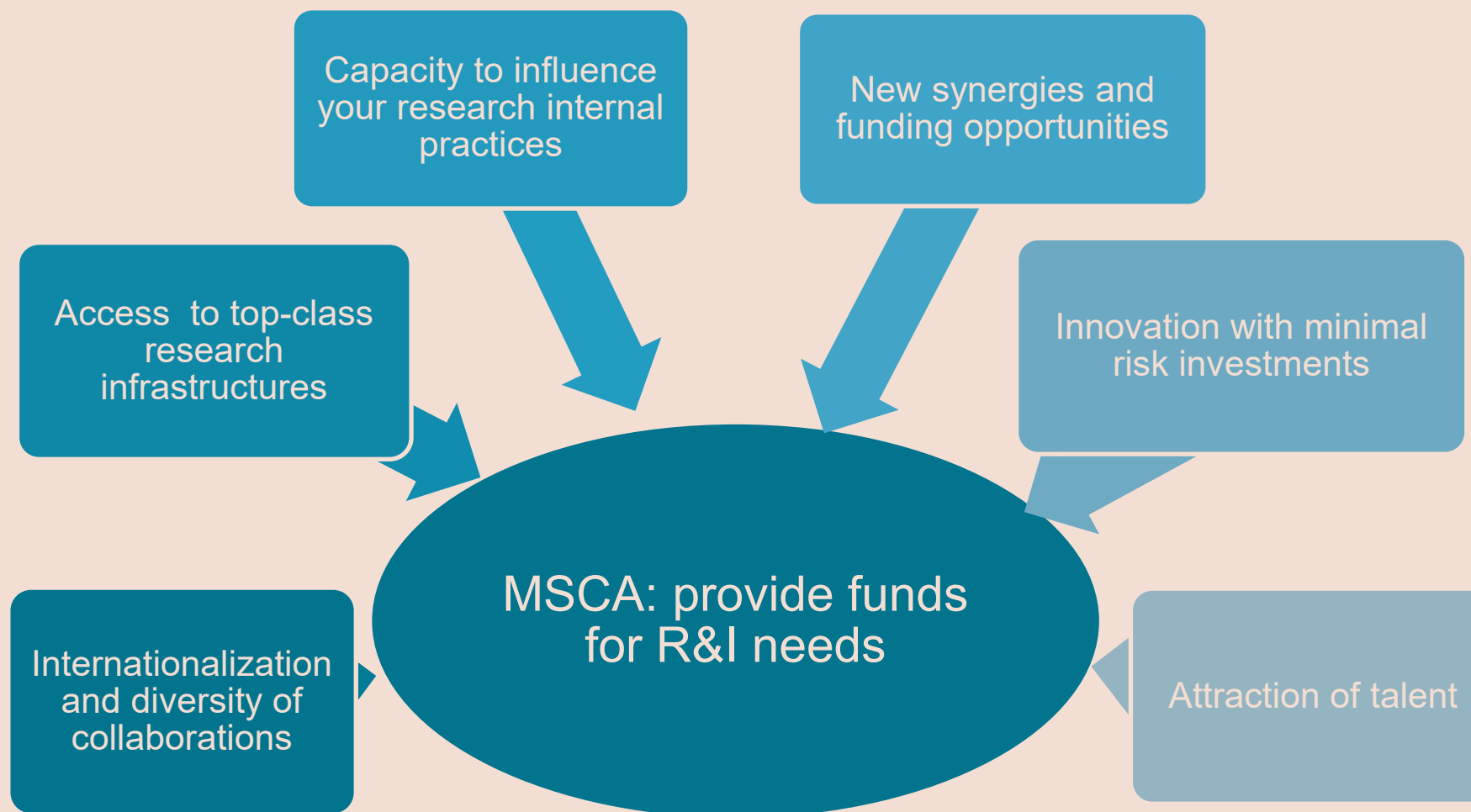

- ❑ Solid management structure
- ❑ Coordinator with proved management structure: convince evaluator an efficient project implementation
- ❑ Management mechanism that allows researchers to concentrate on that

- ✓ Previous skills and experience
- ✓ Adequate infrastructure and resources
- ✓ Excellent and interested researchers
- ✓ Contributing to “triple I” dimension
- ✓ Gender balance
- ✓ Synergies and complementary between members
- ✓ Previous collaborations are well seen
- ✓ Commitment and trust are essential

Ask yourself:

- Are the partners eligible?
- Are roles and responsibilities clear?
- Are all target audiences covered?

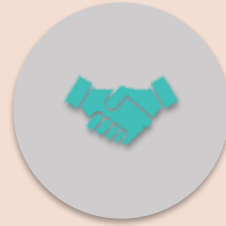
